

STATE SELECTION BOARD, ODISHA POLICE, CUTTACK. Advertisement for written examination for the post of Constables in 9th India Reserve Battalion (Specialised).

The Written Examination for recruitment of Constables in 9th India Reserve Battalion (Specialised) for those candidates who qualified in the Physical Measurement and Physical Efficiency Test held between 16.01.2017 to 05.03.2017 will now be held on 09.04.2017(Sunday).

- 1. The Written Examination will be held at two Venues i.e. at Kalinga Institute of Industrial Training (KIIT) University Campuses, Bhubaneswar and Barabati Stadium, Cuttack.
- 2. The date and timing for Written Examination at both the venues is 10.00 AM to 10.35 AM on 09.04.2017. The candidates have to report before their respective venues by 7.00 AM to 8.00 AM. After 8.00 AM no entry to the venue will be allowed.
- 3. All the qualified candidates are requested to reach their respective venues well in advance so as to avoid traffic jam and congestion. They may visit their written examination venues prior to the Written Examination date in order to see the route to reach the venue in time. The State Selection Board will not be held responsible for delay in reaching the venue or not able to find the venue. Detail seating plan shall be displayed with respect to each of the venue prominently on a flex board outside the respective main gates of each venue. It shall also be displayed in the website.
- 4. In case of any difficulty in finding the Written Examination venue, the candidates may take the help of google Maps/GPS and from our website i.e. https://lokaseba-odisha.in.
- 5. Help Desks are being set up 2 days in advance near Badambadi Bus Stand and Cuttack Railway Station and for Bhubaneswar at Baramunda Bus Stand and Bhubaneswar Railway Station. Help Desks in front of the main gate of the respective venues also will be available.

6. All the other criteria for the Written Examination as advertised earlier will remain unchanged. All the qualified candidates are requested to visit the website i.e. https://lokaseba-odisha.in regularly to download their e-Pass (Hall Ticket) by using their log-in id and password to appear in the Written Examination at the respective venues as mentioned in the e-pass.
